

Vieilles vignes

Acquired by Olivier's family in 2003, the vineyard of Bourgueil appellation was planted 50 years ago. Rehabilitated before, the Bourgueil's vineyard product a different wine compared with Saint Nicolas, more structure and balanced. To ensure the difference with Saint Nicolas's wines, the vineyard of Bourgueil located in the center of Bourgueil's appellation.

The smell is very intensive with aromas of undergrowth and chocolate. This wine is characteristic of spring wine with a soft and round mouth. It have a typical aromas of blackberry and an exceptional long finish.
